

How to Set-up Cleo Clarify to Recognize Inbound 997s in Dashboard



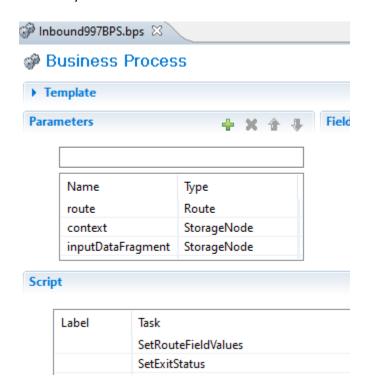
By default, the current Cleo Dashboard (3.3.4) does not associate a trading partner with inbound EDI 997s (below). This is due to Clarify being unable to match a Trading Partner object to the inbound 997 in Clarify.

1 SETUP - BUSINESS PROCESS

In Cleo Clarify create an Inbound 997 EDI Route Business Process.

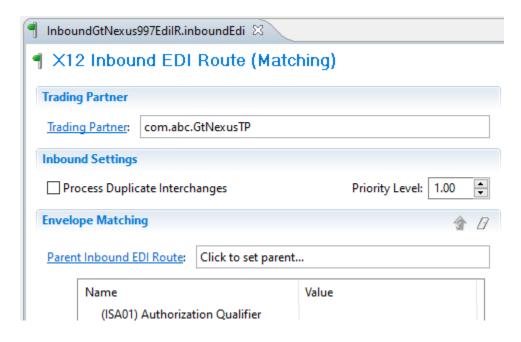
The newly created Business Process will contain the two default tasks (below).

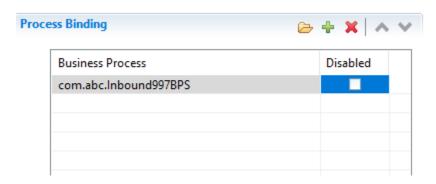


2 SETUP – INBOUND ROUTE

An Inbound Route will need to be created for each 997 document you want to see a Trading Partner attached to.

The example trading partner will be GtNexus.





Once created, a 997 coming in for GtNexus in the Cleo Dashboard.
